Since 1984 over 280,000 trees have been planted by thousands of volunteers. These provide new habitat for released species such as the red-crowned parakeet, North Island saddleback, whitehead, brown teal, takahe, North Island robin, little spotted kiwi, stitchbird, North Island kokako, fernbird, tuatara, North Island tomtit and rifleman.

While Tiritiri Matangi is an outstanding success, the project still requires help. We continue to improve habitat and visitor facilities, fund research and visitor education programmes.
