

SETTING THE SCENE

SETTING GUIDELINES FOR YOUR WALK



This should be very brief. It is OK to tuck these items in where appropriate along the way.

WHAT ARE YOU LEARNING?

Find out what the main focus of the visit is and gauge the knowledge level of the group.



WHAT WOULD YOU LIKE TO EXPERIENCE?



Ask the group if they have anything in particular they are hoping to see/experience, anything they are passionate or have a lot of knowlede about.

ESTABLISH BOUNDARIES

State expectations clearly.
For example guide leads, group keeps together, one person speaks at a time, no running ahead.



ENGAGE ADULT HELPERS

Thank adults for coming and ask them to help support learning and manage behaviour.

USE SENSES

Encourage students to use all their senses for the best experience. We are all looking, listening, smelling and feeling.



ENGAGE STUDENTS

Start with something interesting or funny Eg: "You have come at the best time when all the chicks are fledging"
